The Bryant Lausberg Scholarship Trust is in memory of our son and brother, Bryant. Bryant was a top ten graduate from Somersworth High School, Class of 2007. During his high school years not only did he excel in academics, he was an All-State athlete in football, hockey and baseball.

He attended Plymouth State University where he earned two degrees, one in Health Education and one in Physical Education. Bryant was appointed captain of the Plymouth State Baseball Team his senior year and graduated Cum Laude. After he graduated, he was a graduate assistant baseball coach (at Plymouth) while teaching in Concord and pursuing his Master's degree.

When a teaching position opened in Rollinsford, Bryant decided to return to the Seacoast so that he could give back to the communities that meant so much to him. He was a Health/PE teacher at Rollinsford Grade School, Head Coach for the Marshwood High School Baseball Team, Head Coach for the Somersworth/Coe-Brown Bearcat Hockey Team and was the Rollinsford Recreation Director.

In memory of Bryant, we will be awarding two \$500 scholarships. The requirements for this scholarship are:

- you are a resident of Somersworth or Rollinsford
- you will be attending a two or four year degree or certificate program
- you participated in high school athletic activities
- you will graduate with a GPA of 3.0 or better
- you fill out the application
- complete a one page or less essay on how athletics has impacted your life
- you submit all required documentation (including transcript) by deadline
