#### Scholarship Application

The Walter and Pauline Calderwood Foundation announces its Scholarship Award Program, which awards scholarships to high school seniors who are residents of New Hampshire, with preference being given to students residing in Strafford or Carroll County, New Hampshire.

**Purpose**: To support qualified students in need of financial aid for the purpose of attending a four-year college or university after graduation from high school.

#### Criteria:

- Strafford or Carroll County, New Hampshire high school senior
- Current high school GPA and class rigor (minimum GPA of 3.0)
- Extracurricular activities
- Character and integrity
- Financial need
- Plan to attend a four-year college or university

**Application Process:** Each applicant must submit the following items to the Foundation:

- Completed application form (must be hand printed or typed)
- Most recent official high school transcript (photocopies will not be accepted)
- SAT and/or ACT scores (photocopy of official scores)
- Recommendation letters from two teachers or guidance counselors at the applicant's high school, or from the high school principal
- Proof of acceptance at an accredited four year college or university
- Personal Essay

**IMPORTANT**: Please send complete application flat (do not fold), do not use any staples and avoid double sided printing. We may need to ask for more information. We will use the email address you provide to do this. Make sure you provide an address that you check often. Thank You!

<u>DEADLINE</u> for scholarship applications is <u>March 31</u> (no exceptions). The application (and all attachments and supporting documentation) must be postmarked no later than March 31.
